

Finding your Town Boot size

The chart below is for our [Town Sheepskin Boots](#) only. If you are unsure, please measure your foot and check against the maximum foot length measurements below.

Foot measurements

Measure your bare foot to be sure of the exact size. Place your heel against a wall and measure from the wall to the furthest tip of your longest toe, (usually your big toe). You can stand on a ruler or measuring tape (but be sure to account for the space on the ruler before zero). We need the exact length of your foot - it can be in inches or centimeters, but you must be in bare feet.

Sheepskin boots will stretch slightly, and the pile will compact, so it is important that they fit reasonably snug to start off.

Wide feet?

Don't worry; the leather will stretch out naturally. Don't order a larger size of our boots because of wide feet, unless they are extraordinarily wide.

Compare worldwide shoe sizes

You can let us know your size and/or foot measurement in the comments box at "check out" if you are not sure. (Boots should be snug fitting to start and will loosen up a bit with wearing.)
